Year 12 Enrolment Information

As results day approaches, the Sixth Form team would like to share with you the arrangements for enrolment in Chiswick Sixth Form and the procedures for the start of term in September. You should have heard from us regarding your conditional acceptance to study here with us this year. We hope that you have enjoyed the opportunities provided to prepare for Sixth Form study during this year and that you are looking forward to taking the next step along your progression route with us at Chiswick.

Enrolment will take place on results day, Thursday 12th August. If there are exceptional circumstances which prevent you from attending to enrol on results day there will be alternative enrolment opportunities on Friday 27th August from 10am - 12pm and on Tuesday 31st August from 10am-12pm. However, once again, we have had many applications this year and it could be that by this time your subject choice options are limited. If you know already that you will be unable to make results day or are not intending to take up your place at Chiswick in September, please contact Ms. Ward on lwa@chiswickschool.org.

The following arrangements will be in place for internal and external students

Internal Chiswick school students:

Results will be issued to students from 8.30am in the Sports Hall, please use the entrance on Staveley Road. After receiving results, students should make their way to the Sixth Form through the Sixth Form garden where they can then enrol on courses for Year 12

Please note results CANNOT be given to parents, family members or friends without a signed letter from the student. We can accept this in the form of a signed, handwritten letter or an email from the student's school account.

External students:

External students should collect their GCSE results from their current school and can enrol at the Sixth Form from 11am on Thursday 12th August. It is imperative that you bring your GCSE results with you and a form of I.D (passport usually).



The table below is a reminder of our general entrance criteria. Subject specific requirements can be found on our website.

If you do not achieve the grades you had hoped for and do not meet your conditional offer, you should still attend enrolment, so that we can discuss alternative pathways within the Sixth Form or elsewhere.

OCR Level 3 Extended Certificates	Grade Merit at BTEC Level 2 if studied previously
WJEC Level 3 Applied Diploma	

Introduction to Sixth Form
