

## Chiswick School Learning Strategy Summer Term 2 Year 7 - 12

While the government does not expect Year 10 or Year 12 to return to school on a full time basis they are asking secondary schools to offer some face to face support to these pupils in the summer term. ### The school has also:

- surveyed all parents on two occasions
- surveyed all parents of Year 10 to consult on in school provision from June 1st
- analysed the engagement of Year 12 and Year 10 students in relation to remote learning
- surveyed staff
- reviewed the remote offer that has been in place up to this point
- considered union guidance and consulted with NEU reps
- consulted with other school leaders in Hounslow secondary schools to compare strategy
- consulted with Governors

- considered ratio and demands on staffing including those staff who are shielding or live with someone who is shielding, have young children of their own
- considered staff absence which could potentially be impacted by the guidance on isolation
- considered the demands on supporting the needs of vulnerable children and the children of key workers.

#### Teaching staff have to this point:

- delivered a proportion of live lessons to Year 12 and set work to mirror the timetable
- uploaded lesson activities to mirror the Year 10 timetable
- produced lessons for Year 7, 8 and 9 (KS3) Ebacc Subjects (English, maths, science history, geography, MFL) using a variety of methods: pre-recorded lessons which can be accessed at any time, set work from the CGP workbooks so that children with limited access to IT can access learning, used online platforms to set work
- staff have also delivered over 100 laptops and food parcels to families who have told us they don't have enough food, delivered learning packs, made phone calls to their tutees and actions from this
- in addition to this teachers are seconded to a weekly rota -up to 30 students who are children of key workers or have EHCP or are vulnerable come to school each day
- teachers have also been adapting their curriculum and schemes of learning for each class to take into account the learning gaps that will exist.

#### Key principles that have been considered when shaping the strategy:

- that children and staff are safe and the school is in a position to ensure that risk is as reduced as possible through adaptations of policy, site and logistics.
- that children and parents are supported during school closure and partial opening to ensure that they are not disadvantaged either academically or socially, initially giving priority to children with SEND
- that the remote offer needs to be continually reviewed and developed with increased expectations of students and parents from Summer Term 2
- the premise that the school needs to be ready to accommodate staff and students on site from September 2020 dependent on Government guidelines.
